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#### **FORM OF AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT is made on the day \_\_\_ 2024 between Embassy of India, Kathmandu, Nepal (hereinafter referred to as "the Buyer") of the one part and hereinafter called "the Supplier") of the other part. WHEREAS the Buyer is desirous of procurement of **05 Units of Type-A [Advance Life Support (ALS)** and 35 Units of Type-B [Basic Life Support (BLS)] Ambulances for gifting to various hospitals / health posts / health institutions / organizations in different parts of Nepal under "India – Nepal Cooperation" programme in accordance with all the requirements as set out in the contract. AND WHEREAS the Supplier/s has submitted tender and the Buyer has accepted the tender submitted by Supplier/s for: (Indian Rupees only) towards price of 05 Units (i) total amount of INR of Type-A [Advance Life Support (ALS) Ambulances all cost inclusive, compliant to Government of Nepal extant norms/guidelines; and (ii) the total amount of INR (Indian Rupees only) towards price of 35 Units of Type-B [Basic Life Support (BLS)] Ambulances all cost inclusive, compliant to Government of Nepal extant norms/guidelines.

The whole supply comprised in this Agreement shall be completed within **45 days** from placing of order. The maintenance service provided to maintain the ambulances in good order for the specified Warranty period from the date of supply in conformity in all respects with provisions of the agreement.

- i. **Performance Security:** The Supplier shall submit 5% of Tendered Cost before the award of work in the form of a Bank Guarantee from Nationalized / Commercial / Scheduled Bank registered in Nepal or from any Schedule Bank registered in India valid for a period of sixty days beyond the date of the completion of all the contractual obligations of the Supplier under the contract and discharged after completion of work.
- ii. **Retention money:** 5% of contract amount shall be retained by the buyer (in the form of Bank Guarantee to be submitted by the Supplier/s for the contract amount) till the defect liability period of one year is over.

- iii. **Liquidated Damages:** In case of delay in delivery of ambulances, by the stipulated date, the supplier/s shall be liable to pay delayed charges @ 0.1% of the value of supply order for each day of delay attributable to the supplier, subject to maximum of 10%.
- iv. **Defect Liability Period:** Vehicles to be supplied shall be under warranty period for at least 01 year from the date of supply against all manufacturing defects. The supplier shall ensure free maintenance on site for 1 year from the date of supply. Preferably the bidder shall have authorised service provider in Nepal.
- v. **Payment Modalities:** Payment shall be made by SBI Cheque in favour of the manufacturer drawn on State Bank of India, payable at par anywhere in India after satisfactory delivery of ambulances to the Embassy of India, Kathmandu. Clearing & Forwarding and Transportation charges of the ambulances, if any, already included in the bid itself.

#### NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. In this agreement words and expressions shall have the same meaning as are respectively assigned to them in the terms and conditions of agreement hereinafter referred to.
- 2. The agreement shall consist of this Form of Agreement, and the following documents, all of which by this reference are incorporated herein and shall form part thereof:
  - a. Tender Press Notice
  - b. Instructions to Bidders
  - c. Terms and Conditions
  - d. Form of Tender
  - e. Acceptance of Tender
  - f. Earnest Money Deposit
  - g. Explanatory notes, correspondences and/or minutes of meetings (if any)
- 3. The aforesaid documents shall be taken as complementary and mutually explanatory of one another, but in the case of ambiguities or discrepancies the terms and conditions of the tender document shall be final.
- 4. In consideration of the payment to be made by the Buyer to the Supplier/s as hereinafter mentioned, the Supplier/s hereby covenants with the Buyer to deliver, complete and maintain the ambulances in conformity in all respects with the provisions of the agreement.
- 5. The Buyer hereby covenants to pay the Supplier/s in consideration of the supply, delivery and maintenance, the price at the time and in the manner prescribed by the agreement.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

(i) **Scope of the bid:** Supply and delivery of Ambulances to Embassy of India (DP Wing), Kathmandu shall be made in the following manner:

<b>Delivery period</b>	Units of Ambulances to be supplied

The supplier/s must adhere to the above timelines as the ambulances would be gifted in the current financial year (2024-25). The penalty of 0.1% of the contract amount per day would be levied in case of delay including annulling of the contract, subject to maximum 10% of tender cost.

- (ii) **Tender Document:** Tender document can be obtained from DP Wing, Embassy of India, 336 Kapurdhara Marg, P.O. Box No. 292, Kathmandu from 19/08/2024 to 08/09/2024 during 1000 hrs. to 1700 hrs. Tender document can be downloaded from the website of Embassy of India Kathmandu at <a href="https://www.indembkathmandu.gov.in">www.indembkathmandu.gov.in</a> and Central Public Procurement Portal at <a href="https://www.eprocure.gov.in">www.eprocure.gov.in</a>.
- (iii) **Eligibility Criteria:** Only Original Manufacturers/Authorized dealers of Indian manufactured vehicles/ambulances with 5 years of manufacturing/dealership in last immediate 7 years and having minimum experience of 3 years for supply of similar vehicles in last immediate 7 years are eligible to participate in the tender process.
- (iv) **Financial Statements**: Annual financial statements for last 05 years duly certified by CA to be submitted with technical bid. Must have average annual financial turnover during immediate last 03 financial years as mentioned in the below table. Should not have incurred losses in more than two years during immediate last five financial years and no loss in immediate previous financial year.

- (v) **Solvency**: Must have solvency of the amount at-least as mentioned at para (iv) above table (duly certified by bank). The solvency certificate should not be older than 06 months as on the last date of bid submission.
- (vi) **Single Stage Two Bid System:** The bids are called in Single Stage with two Bid system: Part I-Technical bid and Part II Financial Bid.
- (vii) **Performance Security:** 5% of the Tendered Cost before the award of work in the form of a Bank Guarantee from Nationalized / Commercial / Scheduled Bank registered in Nepal with Government of Nepal or from Scheduled Bank registered in India valid for a period of sixty days beyond the date of the completion of all the contractual obligations of the Supplier under the contract and discharged after completion of work.
- (viii) **Time for completion:** Time for supply of vehicles is within 45 days from the date of award of work.
- (ix) **Payment Terms:** Payment shall be made by SBI Cheque, Embassy of India, Kathmandu in favour of the manufacturer drawn on State Bank of India, payable at par anywhere in India after satisfactory delivery of ambulances to the Embassy of India, Kathmandu.. Clearing & Forwarding and Transportation Charges of the ambulances at Embassy of India, Kathmandu, if any, should be included in the bid itself.
- (x) **Defect Liability Period**: Vehicles to be supplied shall be under warranty period for at least 01 year from the date of supply against all manufacturing defects. The supplier shall ensure free maintenance on site for 1 year from the date of supply. Preferably the bidder shall have authorised service provider in Nepal.
- (xi) **Certificate to be provided by dealers:** Bid should be accompanied by a duly attested copy of the certificate of dealership from the manufacturer company and Government of Nepal. The certificate shall be valid on the last day of submission of bid.

- (xii) **Clarification:** Prospective bidders can obtain further information and any clarification regarding bidding document from DP Wing, the Embassy of India, 336 Kapurdhara Marg, P.O. Box No. 292, Kathmandu (phone # 4419847) from **19/08/2024 to 08/09/2024** during 1000 hrs. to 1700 hrs.
- (xiii) **No. of bids per bidder:** Each bidder shall submit only one bid. A bidder who submits more than one bid shall be disqualified.
- (xiv) **Cost of bidding:** The bidder shall bear all the costs associated with the preparation and submission of bid and this Embassy shall in no case be responsible or liable to these costs.
- (xv) **Amendment of bidding document:** The Embassy may amend the bidding document by issuing Addenda, before the deadline for submission of bids.
- (xvi) **Language:** All documents relating to the bid shall be in English language.
- (xvii) **Earnest Money:** Deposit each bid shall be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) with the validity of 90 days as in the table below in the form of a account payee bank draft / bank guarantee in favour of Embassy of India, Kathmandu from Nationalized / Commercial / Scheduled Bank registered in Nepal with Government of Nepal or from Scheduled Bank registered in India.

- (xviii) **Refund of Earnest Money:** Earnest Money deposited by the successful bidder/supplier/s shall be released after 60 days on receipt of a request from the Supplier/s after satisfactory delivery of each type of ambulance/s, complete in all respects, in ready to gift condition. Earnest Money Deposit of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned in original after completing the process of evaluation of bids.
- (xix) **Place of Supply**: The Embassy of India, Kathmandu. No Transportation charges will be payable to the bidder.
- Submission of Tender: In two separate envelope in which <a href="Envelope-1">Envelope-1</a> shall contain all the documents submission for Technical Bid including EMD. Completed tenders in all respects alongwith enclosures shall be sealed. <a href="Envelope-2">Envelope-2</a> shall contain all the Financial Bid documents. Completed tenders in all respects shall be sealed. The completed tenders of sealed <a href="Envelope-1">Envelope-1</a> and <a href="Envelope-2">Envelope-2</a> in all respects shall be submitted in a sealed <a href="Envelope-3">Envelope-3</a> which shall be superscribed "TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF 05 Units of Type-A [Advance Life Support (ALS)] AND 35 Units of Type-B [Basic Life Support (BLS)] OF AMBULANCES". (One photocopy of the tender document should also be enclosed)
- (xxi) **Last date for submission of Tender:** Tenders shall be submitted <u>upto 1200 hrs. of 09/09/2024</u>. Tenders shall be submitted to DP Wing, Embassy of India, 336 Kapurdhara Marg, P.O. Box No. 292, Kathmandu. Bids received after the stipulated time shall not be entertained.
- (xxii) **Contents of bid:** The following documents and addenda, if any, shall form part of the tender for delivery of (a) 05 Units of TYPE-A and (b) 35 Units of TYPE-B Ambulances to the Embassy of India (DP Wing), Kathmandu.

- (xxiii) **Opening of bids**: Bids shall be opened in the Embassy of India, Kathmandu <u>at 1500 hrs on 09/09/2024.</u>
- (xxiv) The bidder shall sign each page of this document and no page of this document shall be removed by the bidder. Any cutting shall also be attested by the bidder.
- (xxv) The Embassy reserves the right to reject or accept any application without assigning any reason.

#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- 1. **Price:** The price shall be quoted excluding Indian Excise, Nepalese Customs and other duties. Embassy of India, Kathmandu shall issue necessary letter to the concerned tax authorities of India and Nepal regarding exemption from taxes and duties. Clearing & Forwarding and Transportation charges of the ambulances, if any, should be included in the bid itself. The supplier shall also submit original invoice and details of chassis number and engine number of all the ambulances well in advance to obtain necessary tax exemption from the relevant authorities of Government of Nepal.
- 2. **Currency:** All rates shall be quoted in Indian Rupees (INR 1.00 = NRs.1.60).
- 3. **Performance Guarantee:** Successful bidder/s shall have to deposit Performance Guarantee equal to 5% of the tendered cost of each type of ambulances from Nationalized / Commercial / Scheduled Bank registered in Nepal with Government of Nepal or from Scheduled Bank registered in India at the time of award of work.
- 4. **Pre-delivery Inspection:** The successful bidder shall conduct pre-delivery inspection of ambulances and remove all mechanical, electrical, and physical defects, if any, before delivery of the ambulances to the Embassy of India. The bidder shall submit the internal Inspection Report of the company along with the supplies before claiming the payment.
- 5. **Inspection by Embassy:** Embassy of India, Kathmandu shall also undertake physical inspection of the ambulances through its representatives before taking their delivery. This shall, however, not be treated as discharge of the responsibility of suppliers for pre-delivery inspection of the ambulances.

7. **Delivery:** Successful bidder/s shall be required to deliver the ambulances in premises of EoI, Kathmandu complete in all respects in ready to gift condition within **45 days** from and including the date of the award of work. The supply shall be made in the following manner:

- 8. **Liquidated Damages:** In the case of delay in delivery of ambulances, if any, the supplier/s shall be liable to pay a penalty of 0.1% of the value of supply order for each day of delay attributable to the supplier, subject to maximum of 10%.
- 9. **Retention Money:** 5% of contract amount shall be retained by the buyer (in the form of Bank Guarantee to be submitted by the Supplier/s for the contract amount) till the defect liability period of one year is over.
- 10. **Payment:** Payment shall be made by SBI Cheque in favour of the manufacturer drawn on State Bank of India, payable at par anywhere in India after satisfactory delivery of ambulances to the Embassy of India, Kathmandu. Clearing & Forwarding and Transportation charges of the ambulances, if any, should be included in the bid itself.
- 11. **Warranty:** The supplier/s shall provide warranty of each type of ambulances against manufacturing defects and free services for a period of one year or 25,000 km whichever is later or more if provided by the manufacturer.
- 12. **Refund of Earnest Money and Performance Guarantee:** Earnest Money and Performance Guarantee deposited by the supplier/s shall be released after 60 days on receipt of a request from the Supplier/s after satisfactory delivery of each type of ambulances complete in all respects in ready to gift condition. Any recovery required to be made on behalf of Government of India in respect of the extant tender may be adjusted while refunding the EMD and Performance Guarantee.
