It is uniquely designed to grasp the rich spiritual as well as intellectual system of the Hindus – a distinctively interdisciplinary system where the textual and the oral, the verbal and the visual, the scientific and the metaphysical, the transcendental and the functional are interlocked as parts of a whole. Eligibility for application: Candidates must have obtained at least 55% marks or at least 2.2 GPA out of 4 GPA in Under Graduate degree.

Selection: Eligible candidates will be interviewed through video conferencing. The selected candidates in the interview will be informed by the University through email.

This course will be taught in English medium. Students who are from non-English speaking countries have to submit proof of their proficiency in English (Any standard certification in English Language or studied Under Graduation entirely in English Medium).
