<u>How to apply:</u> The candidates are required to submit **three set** of applications with relevant notarized documents **on or before June 03, 2024** by post/courier or personally at the Education Wing of the Embassy of India, Kathmandu between 09:30 hrs. to 12:30 hrs. along with the following documents:

- i. Duly filled application form with one recent passport size photograph pasted on it. (3 sets)
- ii. Notary Public attested photocopy of Date of Birth certificate issued by Municipality.
- iii. Notary Public attested photocopy of marks sheets, certificates and degrees of examinations passed.
- iv. Notary Public attested photocopy of citizenship (in English transcript) of self, father & mother.
- v. Notary Public attested photocopy of character certificate issued by the university/institution last attended.

The applications which are incomplete or the requisite documents are either not submitted or are not properly notarized, will not be considered for scholarship.

THE INSTITUTE

Forest Research Institute (FRI), Dehra Dun made a humble beginning from the Forest School established in 1878. Initially named as Imperial Forest Research Institute, FRI came into being in 1906. Later renamed as Forest Research Institute and Colleges, it had a number of Centers located at different places all over the country administering research as well as training of Forest Officers and Forest Rangers. In 1988, on reorganization of Forestry Research in the Country and creation of Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE), the Training and Research Centres were given independent status. FRI, now one of the institutes under ICFRE, was conferred the status of Deemed University in December 1991, on the recommendation of U.G.C., Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.

MEA-FRI Scholarship (10)

Ministry of External Affairs, Govt. of India has decided to award 10 Scholarships per year to the students of BIMSTEC Members States viz, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka and Thailand. for pursuing Post Graduate Courses at Forest Research Institute Deemed to be University, Dehradun(Uttarakhand) India.

THE COURSES OFFERED

MASTER OF SCIENCE (2 YEARS)

- Forestry
- Wood Science & Technology
- **Environment Management**
- Cellulose & Paper Technology

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

M.Sc. (Forestry): B.Sc. degree in science with at least one of the subjects namely Botany, Chemistry, Geology, Mathematics, Physics, Zoology or a Bachelor's degree in Agriculture or Forestry. The candidate having 50% or above marks may apply.

M.Sc. (Environment Management): B.Sc. degree in any branch of basic or

applied Sciences or Bachelor's degree in

Forestry or Agriculture or BE in Environment Science. The candidate having 50% or above marks may apply.

M.Sc. (Wood Science & Technology): B.Sc. degree with Physics, Mathematics and Chemistry or B.Sc. degree in Forestry. The candidate having 50% or above marks may apply.

M.Sc. (Cellulose & Paper Technology): B.Sc. degree with minimum 50% marks in aggregate in Science with Chemistry as one of the subjects. BE/ B.Tech. (Chemical or Mechanical Engineering with minimum 50% aggregate).

Candidates from South Asian countries are exempted from appearing in the M.Sc. Admission test provided they have passed above mentioned eligibility requirements from a university outside India and fulfilled the following conditions.

- 1. The candidates must have a valid residential permit in India granted for students Visa for studies/ prescribed duration of the concerned
- 2. The antecedents of the candidates must have been verified by the local Government/ Govt. of India and found
- 3. The degree/certificate of the candidates must have been approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) equivalent to the or corresponding degrees/ certificates of the AIU,
- 4. Candidates must have adequate knowledge of English (10+2) level as per requirements of the course as the medium of instruction is English.

CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM

The FRI Deemed to be University has implemented the Choice Based Credit System for M.Sc. courses of FRI Deemed to be University from the session 2016-2017.

NUMBER OF SEATS

1. Total 10 seats are available for MEA-FRI Scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The Application duly filled in by the candidates must be sent to BIMSTEC & SAARC Division, Ministry of External Affairs, Govt. of India, New Delhi through the concerned Indian mission abroad, for its onward submission to the Registrar, FRI Deemed to be University, Post Office, I.P.E., Kaulagarh Road, Dehradun (India) by 14th June, 2024. The Selected candidates would be informed latest by 24th June, 2024 and would be expected to join the course by First week of July, 2024. The course would end by June, 2026.

SCHOLARSHIP

The Ministry of External Affairs, Govt. of India will provide a modest Scholarship amounting to Rupees 353163/- for the full course to each selected student to support Tuition, Sports & Magazine, Library/ Teaching Aid, Hostel and Degree Fees. The Mess charges will be paid by the students themselves. The caution money Rupees 4175/- which is refunded after the completion of the course, would also be paid by the candidates.

- 1. This is fully residential course and hostels will be provided.
- The Institute provides basic medical facilities to its students.
