The Embassy of India, Kathmandu invites applications for the following scholarship schemes from Nepali nationals to study Post-Graduate courses in ME/M.Tech & M.Sc. (Agri.) in Indian Universities/Institutions for the academic year 2020-21:

<p><b><u>Dr. Homi J. Bhabha Scholarship Scheme (HJBSS) 2020-21</u></b></p> <p>The scholarship scheme is for pursuing Masters in Engineering in India.</p> <p><u>Eligibility</u> : Applicants should be 25 years or less as on July 1, 2020 and should have minimum 60% aggregate marks in BE and minimum 50% marks in English in Class XII.</p>	<p><b><u>Nepal Aid Fund Scholarship Scheme for M.Sc.(Agri) (NAF-MSc) 2020-21</u></b></p> <p>The scholarship scheme is for pursuing M.Sc.(Agri) Course in India.</p> <p><u>Eligibility</u> : Applicants should be 25 years or less as on July 1, 2020 and should have minimum 60% marks in aggregate in B.Sc. (Agriculture) and minimum 50% marks in English in Class XII.</p>
<p><b>The Last Date for submission of application for these scholarships is May 15, 2020 (Friday)</b></p>	
<p><b>How to Apply :</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Separate application forms should be submitted for each course. The same may be downloaded from the Indian Embassy website <a href="http://www.indembkathmandu.gov.in">www.indembkathmandu.gov.in</a> and filled in, preferably typed. The candidates should attach the following documents (self-attested) with the application form <b>(Only scanned copies of documents need to be attached at this stage):</b><ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) Mark sheets / transcripts of Class XII and Graduation;</li><li>(b) Citizenship certificate;</li><li>(c) Bank Voucher of NRs. 400/-.</li></ol></li><li>2. The application fee of NRs. 400/- should be deposited in favor of Education Wing, EOI, Kathmandu <b>Account No. 17725240200331 of Nepal SBI Bank, anywhere in Nepal not later than May 15, 2020.</b> <u>Application fee once deposited will not be refunded or adjusted.</u></li><li>3. Due care should be taken while exercising option for the course. <b>Candidates are advised to give only one option in the application form.</b> Embassy reserves the right to change the branch choice of a student depending on the placement received from Indian University/College.</li></ol>	
<p><b>How to submit application:</b></p> <p>The candidates may submit their applications (complete in all respect) through email at <a href="mailto:edu2.kathmandu@mea.gov.in">edu2.kathmandu@mea.gov.in</a>.</p>	

**Please Note :**

1. Only those candidates who have passed their Bachelor level examinations can apply for the above (Post- Graduate) courses. Appearing candidates need not apply.
2. Candidates are advised to interact solely with the Education Wing, Embassy of India, Kathmandu or Consulate General of India, Birgunj about the scholarship. The candidates should indicate their address and contact telephone numbers / e-mail address clearly in the prescribed column of the application form. Any change in address/telephone number should also be intimated immediately through a letter.
3. Selection will be based on the applicant's academic record. However, nomination of a candidate by the Embassy does not guarantee admission to any Indian University/College for the above courses. Confirmation of admission by the Embassy will be given only after receipt of the same from the concerned Indian University/College. Request for change of College/Institution or transfer of scholarship upon taking admission will not be entertained. Those candidates who wish to apply to this Embassy for placement in any institution in India will have no right to reject/withdraw at a later stage failing which they will be debarred for future scholarships & would also be required to refund the entire amount spent by Govt. of India.
4. If required, the applicant may be asked to submit hardcopy of the application form in Education Wing, Embassy of India, Kathmandu along with following documents (3 copies of each) :
  - (a) Latest passport size attested photographs;
  - (b) Duly attested marksheets / transcripts of Class XII and Graduation;
  - (c) Citizenship certificate duly translated in English language and certified by Notary Public;
  - (d) Original Bank Voucher of NRs. 400/-.
5. Submission of incorrect information/incomplete application forms by the candidate may result in forfeiture of the scholarship at any stage.
