<u>Diploma in Engineering / Diploma in Pharmacy Courses</u> under Self Financing Scheme(SFS) 2025-26

This Self-Financing Scheme is for pursuing Diploma in Engineering / Diploma in Pharmacy courses in India.

Eligibility Criteria:

<u>Diploma in Engineering Courses</u>: Applicants must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10th standard of CBSE in India - Equivalence Certificate from AIU, New Delhi must be enclosed).

<u>Diploma in Pharmacy</u>: Applicants must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany & Zoology) separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10th standard of CBSE in India - Equivalence Certificate from AIU, New Delhi must be enclosed).

The Last Date for submission of application for the scheme is 20 June, 2025 (Friday).

How to Apply:

- 1. Separate application forms should be submitted for each course. The applicants may download the application form from the website of Indian Embassy www.indembkathmandu.gov.in. The application form (in 4 sets) must be duly filled in (preferably typed) and the following documents (4 Copies notary attested) are to be attached with the form:
 - (a) Application form, duly filled in, with candidate's recent photograph pasted at prescribed place in all the four copies
 - (b) First four pages of the passport.
 - (c) Citizenship certificate with its translation in English;
 - (d) Birth Certificate and its translation in English;
 - (e) Character Certificate from the Head of Institution last attended;
 - (f) Conversion of marks in percentage (%) from the Principal/Head of Institution last attended in a tabular format.
 - (g) Certificates and Mark Sheets with percentage of marks of the qualifying examination i.e. 10^{th} (A certificate from the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi that the candidate's qualifying examination is equivalent to 10th standard of CBSE in India for the purpose of admission to Diploma in Engineering / Pharmacy Courses).

How to submit applications:

The candidates who possess minimum qualifications and are willing to join these courses, should submit their application forms (complete in all respect along with supporting documents) at Education Wing, Embassy of India, Kathmandu between 10.30 am to 12.30 pm from Monday to Friday on or before 20 June 2025 i.e., last date of submission of application form.

Applicants should carry all original documents at the time of submission of application form and he/she should be accompanied by either parent (father/ mother) or guardian [duly authorized and declared as guardian by the parent(s)] to sign the undertaking.

Please Note:

- 1. All the four copies of the application form must be <u>ink-signed</u>. The recent passport size photo of the applicant must be pasted at the given space on all the four copies. The application forms with photocopy of signature and/or photo will be rejected.
- 2. The applicants are advised that merely forwarding their application should not be treated as assurance of their selection. Only those applications that are complete in all respects and applicants meeting the requisite eligibility criteria will be processed for consideration.
- 3. Shortlisted candidates are expected to comply with admission formalities, fee structures and procedures of the respective colleges/universities. These may include specific medical examinations including HIV/ AIDS test in India.
- 4. The list of colleges of respective courses are enclosed at Annexures along with application form. The seats are generally allocated in these Colleges/ Institutes but may vary depending on final allocation of the seats. MBBS/BDS under Self Financing Scheme (SFS) 2025-26

This Self-Financing Scheme is for pursuing MBBS/BDS course in India.

Eligibility:

- (a) Applicants must have secured a minimum of 50% aggregate marks with at least 50% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India Equivalence Certificate from AIU, New Delhi must be enclosed).
- (b) **NEET** It shall be necessary for an applicant to obtain minimum of marks at 50^{th} percentile in NEET UG 2025.

BE/B.Tech/B.Arch/B.Pharmacy under Self Financing Scheme (SFS) 2025-26

This Self-Financing Scheme is for pursuing Bachelor of Engineering (BE/B.Tech) and Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharmacy) courses in India.

Eligibility:

BE/B.Tech & B.Arch: (a) Applicants must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry a nd Mathematics separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India - Equivalence Certificate from AIU, New Delhi must be enclosed).

- (b) Applicants applying for **B.Arch.** course are required to pass the Aptitude Test also as prescribed by the Council of Architecture. The candidates who do not pass the Aptitude Test will not be eligible for award of enrolment by Council of Architecture, New Delhi.
- **B.Pharmacy**: Applicants must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany & Zoology) separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India Equivalence Certificate from AIU, New Delhi must be enclosed).

The Last Date for submission of application for these schemes is 20 June, 2025 (Friday).

Appearing Candidates may also apply pending final declaration of their qualifying examination results equivalent to class 10+2 standard of CBSE. Acceptance of applications of such students will, however, depend upon their being able to obtain required percentage of marks and submission of Class XII Mark-sheet.

Applicants should carry all original documents (mentioned above) at the time of submission of application form and he/she should be accompanied by either parent (father/ mother) or guardian [duly authorized and declared as guardian by the parent(s) and must be carrying his/her Identity Proof and its copy] to sign the undertaking.
