

12 "Maratha Military Landscapes of India", 11 in Maharashtra and 1 in Tamil Nadu, were inscribed in UNESCO's list of World Heritage Sites on 11 July 2025. With this, a total of 44 Indian heritage sites and properties are now on the UNESCO's World Heritage Sites list.



UPI become's world's no. 1 real-time payment system

The Unified Payments Interface (UPI), designed by the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI), launched in 2016 by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), has emerged as the world's leading real-time payment system, accounting for nearly 50% of all digital payments globally, with over 650 million transactions happening every single day.

India achieves its clean energy targets under the 2030 NDC, in the year 2025

India has achieved its clean energy milestone of generating 50% of electricity from non-fossil fuels 5 years ahead of schedule. It reached 20% ethanol blending six years early, and achieved a 40% green energy share in 2021. India also became the first G20 country to meet the Paris Climate Goals, emerging as a global leader in carbon intensity reduction.
