Ambassador's Message

On the occasion of the 73rd Independence Day of India, I extend my warm greetings to all Indian nationals in Nepal. My best wishes also to the friendly people of Nepal, who are the cornerstone of the unique and enduring relationship of India and Nepal.

It is a matter of great pride for us that India has made tremendous achievements on multiple fronts, the latest being the launch of our second mission to the Moon, Chandrayaan-2 which was anchored by two women scientists at the Indian Space Research Organisation.

As the world's largest democracy, General Elections are the fulcrum of India's political life and leadership. Earlier this year, the largest ever electoral exercise in the world was held in India with over 613 million voters electing 542 Members to the Lok Sabha. The people of India made a clear choice for the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, reelecting his party to hold the reins of the Government in a landslide victory. This is a decisive direction from the people of India for a strong and economically prosperous India, which has set its eyes on a GDP target of US Dollars five trillion by 2024. Today we move ahead under the motto of "Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas, Sabka Vishwas". Our relations with Nepal have grown from strength to strength and we had four successive visits at the highest level between two countries in the last two years. This included a visit by Rt. Hon'ble Prime Minister of Nepal K.P. Sharma Oli to New Delhi for the Swearing-in Ceremony of the new Government, which reflects the close and traditionally friendly relations between the two countries. In the coming weeks, the Motihari-Amlekhgunj petroleum products pipeline would be inaugurated. This would be South Asia's first cross-border petroleum pipeline. Thereafter, in the coming months the Integrated Check Post at Birgunj would be operational.

I am also happy that we have made substantial progress in our partnership with Nepal on earthquake reconstruction in the area of housing and in the development of infrastructure, including roads in the Terai.

India continues to be committed towards further strengthening this bilateral partnership and taking it to new heights for the benefit of the people of the two countries. JAI HIND!

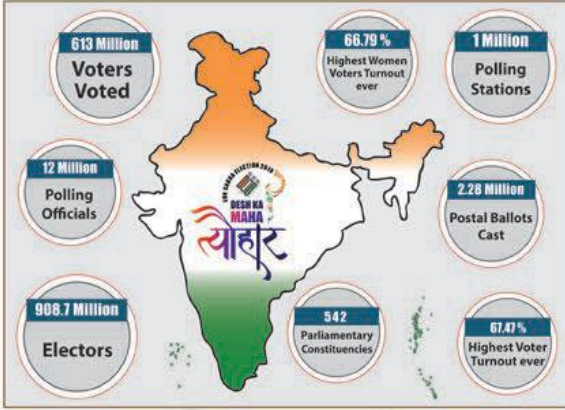
Guru Nanak 550
