Visit of Prime Minister of Nepal Rt Hon'ble Mr. Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda' to India

Successful Completion of Operation Kaveri



On 05 May 2023 External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar announced the successful completion of 'Operation Kaveri' through which nearly 4,000 people, were evacuated from war-torn Sudan.
